PROSPECTIVE APPLICANTS

ENROLLMENT PROCEDURES

DOCUMENTS NEEDED FOR ELIGIBILITY

If under 19 years of age you must be accompanied by parent
or guardian (youth programs)

AND

You must bring the following documents

1. Social Security Card

If you don't have a social security card, you can go to the social security office located at 550 Government St. You will need to take your birth certificate with you to apply for a card.

2. Alabama Driver's License or VALID Alabama state issued ID Card.

3. Proof of your family's household income for the last six months. If you receive SNAP benefits (food stamps), please bring the card.

If you are included in your parent's food stamp budget, please bring your parent with you to sign a SNAP (Food Stamp Release of Information Form).

4. Any applicant 18 and under will need a parent, guardian or someone who has been given permission (via letter) to sign for the client (applicable only if client is enrolling in the youth program).

If the 18 year old client is homeless and lives in a group home, the staff will sign for them and no income is needed.

5. Disabled clients will be eligible, if a letter is sent from the school, Vocational Rehabilitation Service, or a counselor confirming the disability.
